FACE COVERINGS - as of next Saturday, 8th August, face coverings must be worn in church. We will still maintain social distancing, clean the pews after every service and use every other precaution that we have in place already.

CHURCHES OPEN FOR SERVICES - At Saint Cuthbert's the services will be 8am, 10.30am and 6pm on Sunday, 10am on Wednesday, 7pm on Thursday and 12noon on Saturday. At Saint Stephen's there will be a service on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays of the month at 9.15am. If you are shielding and would like to attend a service then Tuesday at 10am in Saint Cuthbert's and Friday at 12noon in Saint Stephen's are available. Please contact Father Nicholas to book one of these. We will be following the guidelines to keep everyone safe and therefore the number of people we can accommodate at the services is governed by the size of the building ensuring 2

metre spacing. It will be helpful to know, in advance, if you are intending to be at the 10.30am service. This is to ensure that we can safely seat family groups as well as individuals.
